

ICE FALL LEAGUE GAME RULES

1. Division III – 1st_4th Grade League will play 4 on 4.

The clock will be stopped throughout gameplay for teaching opportunities, substitutions and the last minute of each half.

All Divisions III, II, I will play 2 - 20 minute halves with the 2nd half 25 minute with substitution of players every 5 minutes. The last 5 minutes of the game any player can play or any substitution can be made.

The clock is a running clock stopping the last minute of each half, substitutions and teaching opportunities.

Halftime will be 2 minutes.

2. Coaches are responsible for giving each player a number for substitution in each game. A substitution number cannot change in the middle of the game. Substitution takes place every five minutes. The clock will stop on all substitutions.

(*The last 5 minutes of the game, any player can play or any substitution can be made.)

- 3. Each team is allowed (2) Full timeouts per half, (4) timeouts total for the game.
- 4. Players foul out at 6 fouls. Bonus is awarded at 10 fouls and is a one-and-one shot. There is no double bonus.
- 5. COACHES: Substitutions are not timeouts. Substitutions should be at dead balls or off of a score. Clocks will stop on substitutions.
- 6. Overtime will consist of an extra one-minute period. 2nd overtime will be sudden death. No extra timeouts will be awarded during overtime. Coaches will be able to substitute freely.
- 7. There is NO PRESS in the Division III (1st-4th Grade League) until the final minute of regulation gameplay, only if a team is down by 10 or more points any team is allowed to press.

There is NO PRESS if a team holds a 15-point lead in Division II & Division I Leagues.

- 8. There is NO Zone Defense at any time. Man to Man Defense Only. (Trapping is allowed.)
- 9. Division III-League will play on 10ft baskets with a 28.5 basketball. Division II-League will play on 10ft baskets with a 29.5 basketball. Division I-League will play on 10ft baskets with a 29.5 basketball.
